Following a weekend strategic planning retreat, GHHS is forming three task forces to address key issues involving the society's growth, communication and responses to member and medical community needs.

Task force one, chaired by Recent Past National Chair, Dr. Cathy Lazarus, will review the GHHS mission and vision, the value and meaning of GHHS membership and its benefits to each member and constituency.
